Overview

The Active Living Coalition is part of the Athmar Park Neighborhood Association and is a group of community members and partners committed to improving public health by promoting and improving the conditions for walking, biking and wheelchair-rolling.

What are the goals of the Athmar Park Active Living Coalition?

- Increase access to safe and accessible routes to the places we work, play, gather, and shop
- Encourage community members to walk, bike, and take public transit
- Advocate for improvements to our built environment that will make it safer and easier to get around and enjoy outdoor spaces
- Provide opportunities for free, accessible physical activity
- Build positive relationships with partners, businesses, community members, and institutional resources

Job Summary

The Athmar Park Neighborhood Association/Active Living Coalition is seeking a person for a part-time contract position as a Community Connector. We are looking for someone who lives in or close to Athmar Park, has bilingual language skills in English and Spanish, and is passionate about connecting with neighbors and community partners.

This is a part-time position with flexible hours but a required availability to attend 1-3 community events per month that often occur in the evenings or weekends (examples: monthly meeting, community market, zumba, bike to school events). Hours will vary throughout the year, as the warm months are busier than the winter months. The Community Connector will record their hours, which will average between 15-30 hours per month. Starting pay rate is \$18/hour, with periodic raises. The position has guaranteed funding until July 2023.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Share information and resources with our community through in person and online outreach and engagement, including use of social media.
- Work with the ALC Program Manager to plan and coordinate meetings and events.
- Engage with neighbors at APNA/ALC events, as well as other community events taking place at our neighborhood schools and other local partners.
- Ensure accessibility of this work by translating information and outreach materials into Spanish.
- Assist in data collection and project evaluation.
- Other opportunities as they arise; implementation of unique ideas is encouraged!

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Experience working with diverse and/or bilingual populations
- Fluency in English and Spanish and strong Spanish translation skills
- Basic computer skills to participate in email and social media communication (Facebook, Instagram), online meetings (e.g. Zoom), and use Microsoft word



- Ability to move around outreach materials (access to a private vehicle and driver's license is helpful), lift up to 30 pounds, and stand for at least half an hour
- There are no educational requirements

Preferred Qualifications

- Be a resident of or have familiarity with the Athmar Park neighborhood
- Connections/relationships with local schools and/or businesses
- Be excited about encouraging physical activity and walking, biking, rolling, and public transit as important forms of mobility
